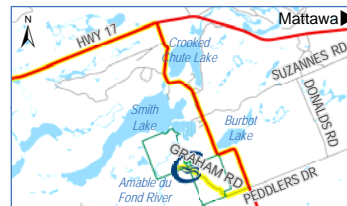


Eau Claire Gorge Conservation Area
